IPYG brings together youth from 119 countries with diverse backgrounds and cultures.

Serving as a global intersection for young people around the world, IPYG operates the informal education program Youth Empowerment Peace Class (YEPC) which is aimed at enhancing capabilities through cross-cultural exchanges.

Since 2020, YEPC, with the participation of 57 countries, provides education on issues related to youth.

After the education, there is an activity assignment.

Through YEPC, participants broaden their knowledge in various fields and recognize the importance of individual roles in achieving a sustainable future and peace.

Following the education, participants have the opportunity to engage in peace activities, showcasing the unique energy, creativity, and capabilities of youth. Through participation, individuals contribute to meaningful endeavors such as peacebuilding and volunteering in their communities, expanding their influence, and creating positive changes in both their personal lives and surroundings.

In its 4th term, YEPC offers courses on the role of a global citizen for sustainable peace, practical knowledge related to youth health, and insights into various world religions and cultures.

- Lesson Topic: The Solutions for Human Rights and World Peace in This Era
- Lesson Objectives:
- 1) Understand the background of the birth of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as a practical model for the DPCW.
- 2) Understand the evolving nature of conflicts in the 21st century and comprehend the solutions presented by the DPCW.
- 3) Recognize the imperative for global youth participation in realizing world peace.

02 Youth Health Education

- Lesson Topic: First Aid
- Lesson Objectives:
- 1) Recognize the importance of First Aid in trauma and outdoor activities.
- 2) Practice what has been learned in students' daily lives.

Religion and Peace Education

- Lesson Topic: About Birth, Aging, Sickness, and Death
- Lesson Objectives:
- 1) Promote understanding of different religions and cultures through the study of scriptures, fostering religious and cultural exchanges.
- 2) Overcome misunderstandings and baseless accusations that lead to extremism and violence against religions by fostering efforts to understand the scriptures, which are the essential teachings of religion, thereby spreading a culture of peace.
