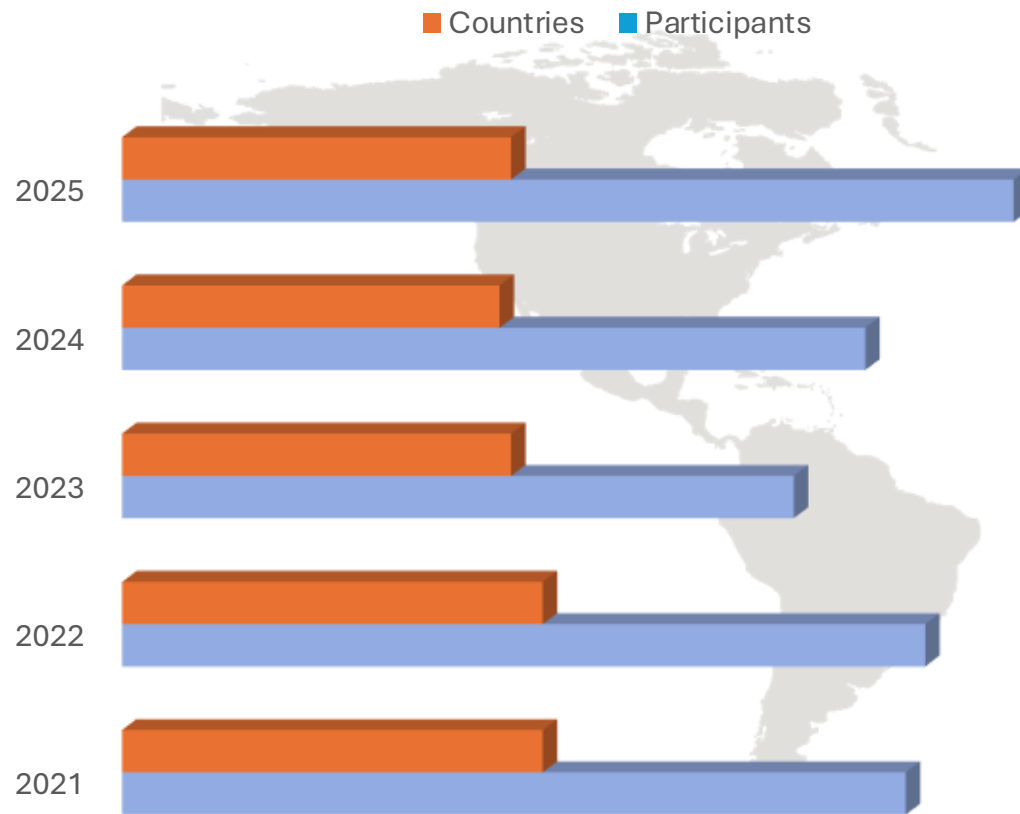
Youth Empowerment Peace Class

Power of Youth, Go Beyond

- The International Peace Youth Group (IPYG), the world's largest youth organization operating in 130 countries, implements the Youth Empowerment Peace Class (YEPC), an informal peace education program designed to enhance the capabilities of young people.
- YEPC provides youth with practical knowledge and a peace-oriented viewpoint to address key youth-related challenges.
- Since its launch in 2020, the program has engaged approximately 6,000 participants, and continues to introduce new educational content each year to reflect evolving youth-related issues.
- The program blends practical skills with core peace values across a variety of educational courses.

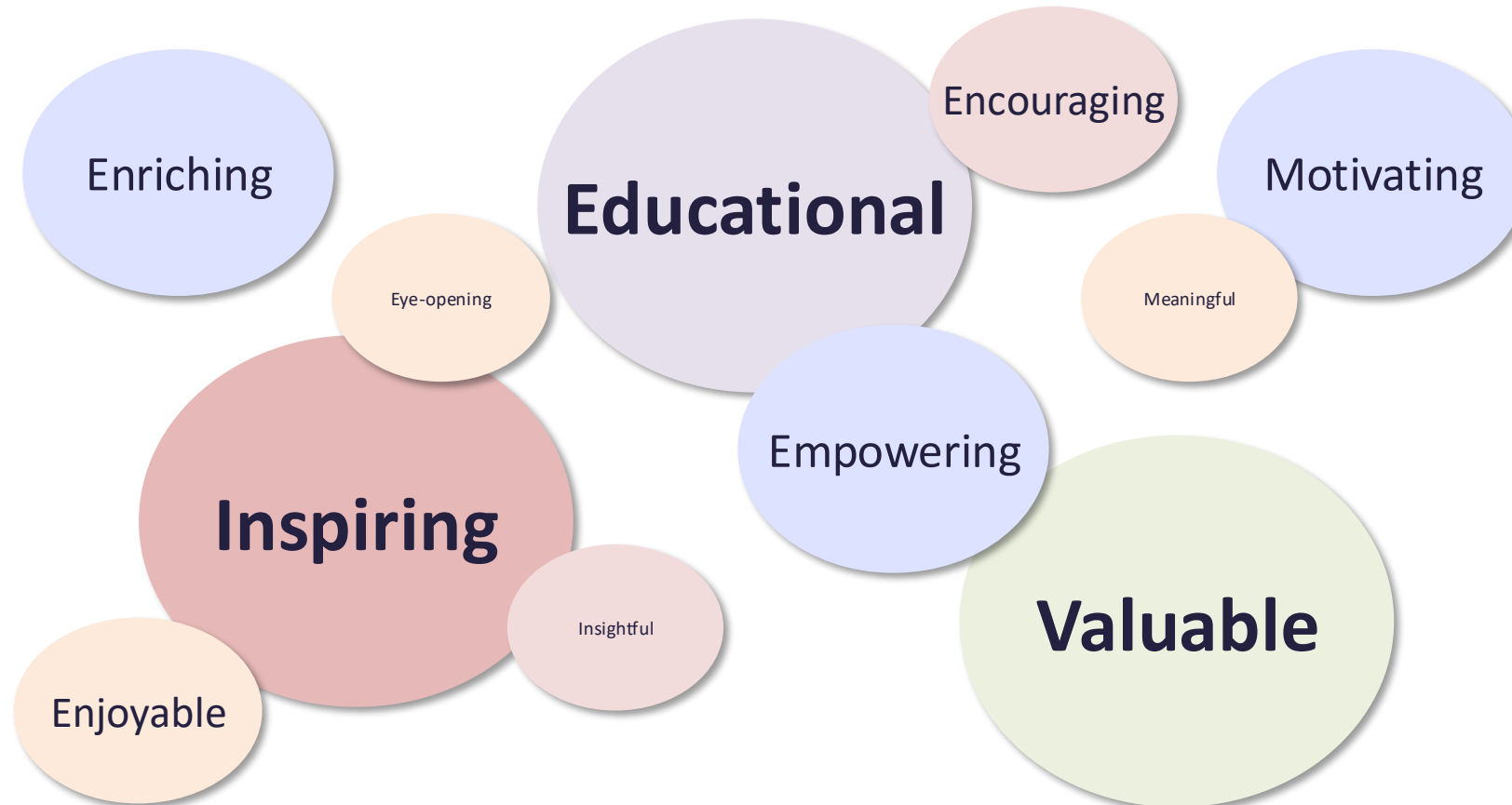

Perspective on Heritage

Many people think of heritage as something left behind in the past. Yet heritage and history continue to be shaped in the present—through our decisions and actions today. Through this course—covering religious and cultural heritage, global festivals and commemorative days, and real-world peace practices—youth come to realize that the most vital link between the past and the future is **people themselves**, and ultimately, *who they choose to become*.

Key Topics

- ✓ Learn to embrace different identities and cultures not as sources of fear, but as subjects of understanding, and to resolve conflicts peacefully.
- ✓ Discover the values and spirit of peace embedded in religious and cultural heritage.
- ✓ Recognize youth as “living heritage” and proactively design the values and roles they will pass on to the next generation.

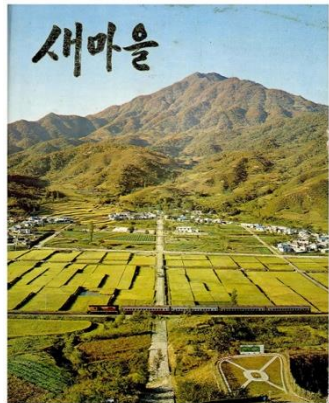

Applied Skill Casestudy – *Saemaul Undong* (*New Community Movement*)

Through the case of Korea's Saemaul Undong, inscribed in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register, youth learn the values of cooperation, responsibility, and participation through real experiences that transformed communities.

This practice-oriented course helps young people discover their own influence and leadership, empowering them to turn peace from an idea into concrete action.
